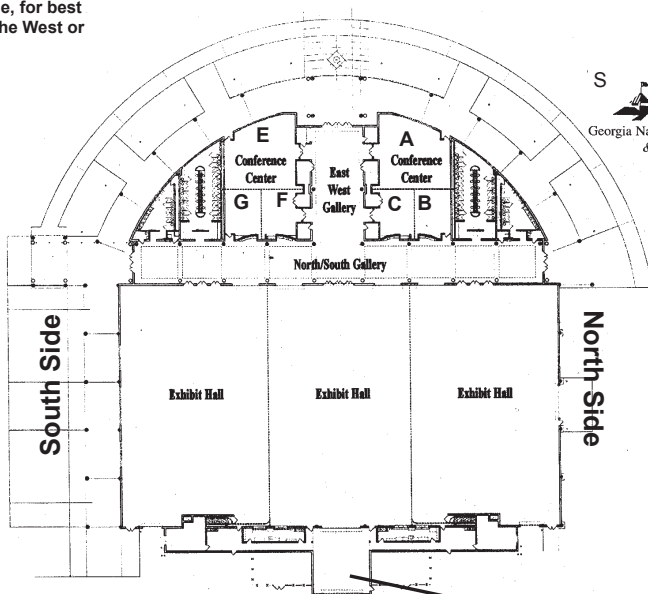
The public is invited to come, watch and talk with the spinners to hear about this fascinating pastime. There will be activities for those interested in trying their hand at drop spinning.
