DELIVERY NOTE: If you are hand delivering to the Fairgrounds and have items that have later delivery dates, e.g., hobbies, wood carving, art, textiles, etc., and you live more than 30 miles away, you may bring those items with your wood turning entries.

- Open to all Georgia residents who are eighteen years of age or older.
- Artists may enter up to three works per category of their own original and untutored work. Works previously shown in this exhibition may not be entered. Works must have been completed within the last three years.
- Wood turning is not juried for acceptance; therefore, no images are required.
- Non-refundable entry fees are \$5 per piece, payable to the Georgia National Fair upon entry form submission September 1.
- Unless specified NFS, it is assumed that all work is for sale. Please provide a sales price with your entry. Artists may also provide a Purchase Award price. No commission will be attached to sales. Sold works must remain on exhibition until the close of the show, October 18, 9:00 p.m.
