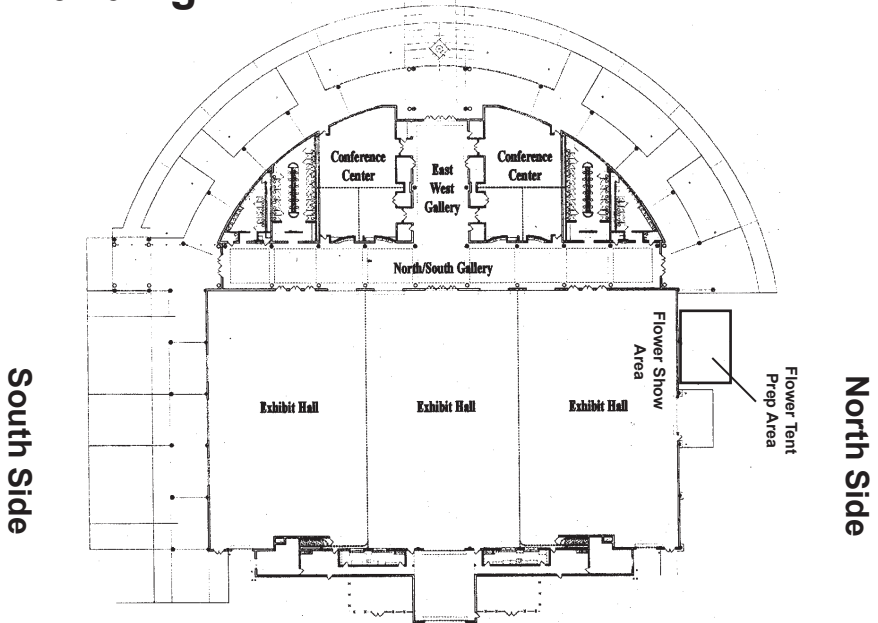

ELIGIBILITY

1. **All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the Georgia National Fair General Rules and Regulations.**
2. All flower shows in this department are open to any amateur gardener in the state of Georgia. No entry fee is required. Please check each show for rules pertaining to that show.
3. Youth Horticulture entries **MUST STATE EXHIBITOR'S SCHOOL ON ENTRY CARD.** Any entry without this information will be judged with adult entries.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

4. Exhibitors must complete an official entry form of the Georgia National Fair to be eligible for cash awards.
5. Special Exhibits and Design Classes of the Standard Flower Show are open to any amateur designer, **but must be registered with the entries chairman.**
6. **PREREGISTRATION IN ALL SECTIONS IS ADVISED.**
7. Only one entry per class, per exhibitor, except where class is subdivided according to color, variety, or kind. Duplicate entry tags will be disqualified.
8. Two or more persons may not exhibit the same variety from the same garden. **Gardens located at the same address are considered the same garden.**
9. Exhibits must be checked by Classification Committee for each show to receive an entry tag. Both entry form and tag must be properly completed by the exhibitor and tag must be attached to exhibit prior to being placed in the show. The decision of the Classification Committee is final. **Exhibitors bringing more than 15 specimens must obtain entry tags in advance and should arrive two hours prior to close of entries for that show.**
10. Exhibits must have been grown by exhibitor or have been in the possession

of the exhibitor for at least three months and be named by common and botanical names (if possible) on the entry tag. Named varieties will be given precedence over unnamed ones. Plants that are staged on a table for the protection of the plant may be elevated with a clay pot not to exceed 15”.

11. **REMOVAL** - No exhibit or part of an exhibit shall be removed at any time during the Fair except by authorized personnel at designated times. Any violation of release time will cause forfeiture of all premiums earned by exhibitor.

12. While the Georgia National Fair and participating flower societies will exercise due caution in safeguarding exhibits, they cannot assume responsibility for injury or loss. Valuables used in exhibits should be insured by the exhibitor.

13. The management reserves the right to reject any exhibit which does not meet its standards for exhibition and the Superintendent shall have the right to remove or exclude from the show at any time any exhibit, or part thereof, which is below the standards of good showmanship.

AWARDS AND PREMIUMS

14. Georgia National Fair ribbons and cash prizes may be awarded in each Class or variety where noted and a Georgia National Fair Rosette may be awarded in Sections where noted. Cash awards (premium checks) will be mailed within six weeks after the Fair is over.

15. Georgia National Sweepstakes Plaque will be awarded to the winner of the most blue ribbons in Horticulture, Division 600.

16. Consult schedules of each show for special awards offered by participating societies and organizations.

DAHLIA SHOW

Exhibits received at the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building on Friday, October 14, beginning at 2:00 p.m. All blooms should be off-loaded by 8:30 p.m. and vehicles moved from the staging area. Exhibitors may work until 10:00 p.m. Friday evening. Staging resumes Saturday, October 15, at 7:00 a.m., ending at 9:00 a.m. Exhibitors must enter the North or West gates, then follow the flower signs and proceed to the designated area at the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building.

EXHIBITOR'S RULES

1. **All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the Georgia National Fair General Rules And Regulations.** Horticulture Department Rules also govern this competition.
2. **The Dahlia Show is open to all growers regardless of state of residence.** In order to receive cash prizes, all exhibitors must complete a registration form. This should be done in advance of the show. Early registration does not obligate participation. Forms may be duplicated.
3. All blooms entered in competition must have been grown by the exhibitor. All blooms entered will become the property of the Georgia National Fair.
4. For exhibition purposes, "New Amateurs" are growers who have entered Dahlia Shows and won ribbon awards in not more than three different years prior to this year.
5. Exhibitors may make as many entries in any class as they choose.
6. All entries will be judged as to their condition at time of judging - not on their appearance before or after judging. All entries shall be made in accordance with the latest "A.D.S. Classification of Dahlias." Unlisted varieties may be listed as they appear. The Show Committee will give assistance in classification if requested.
7. Entry tags will be furnished and must be properly filled out by the exhibitor before any entry may be complete. Entries placed in the wrong class may be corrected by the exhibitor or judges before judging begins.
8. Undissiminated varieties may be entered in any class with name of originator shown on tag.
9. Use of artificial material (wedges, etc.) above the top of container to support the stems will disqualify the entry.
10. Stem length must be: "A", "B" & "BB" not under 18" or over 36"; "All others" not under 8" or over 30". (No tolerance either side is allowed.)
11. Containers will be furnished except that containers for twelves must be furnished by exhibitor and must be neat in appearance.
12. Growers who desire to enter dahlias, but cannot attend, should send flowers prepaid to the Georgia National Fair Horticulture Department to arrive by designated time of show. Please consult General Rules at the beginning of this book for shipping information.
13. Judges may withhold awards when they consider entries unworthy. Entries without competition will be judged on their own merit and will receive an award only if deemed worthy by the judges.
14. The decision of the judges will be final and not subject to change by any committee.
15. Judges may not participate in the judging of their own entries or those in which they have an interest.
16. First award may be made in each Class. First award (Blue Ribbon) counts as 3 points. Ties will be decided by Gold and Purple Ribbons. Tricolor ribbon will be given in "A", "B" and

"BB" sizes. Monetary awards will be given for all blue ribbons and for sweepstakes in each Division.

17. No entry is eligible for any award if it is in violation of either rules or Class specifications.

18. The Show Committee reserves the right to interpret the rules and make further rules for the proper conduct of the show.

19. The Dahlia Society and the Georgia National Fair will exercise due care, but will not be responsible for loss or injury to person or property. All personal property should be properly labeled and picked up at the close of the show, October 16, 7:00 p.m. or during regular release times on Tuesday, October 18.
