The Georgia Living Store is a consignment shop for our exhibitors (ages 18 and above) in the Georgia Living Program.

REQUIREMENTS: In order to sell items in the Store, you must be a 2011 participant in one or more of the Georgia Living competitions at the Fair that arrive on or prior to September 17 (last delivery date for store inventory). You must have confirmed entry for your items to be accepted at the store.

INVENTORY: We hope to stock the Store with a wide variety of **quality** items that have been **hand-made** (a must!) by our talented exhibitors and are representative of the Georgia Living Competitions ... woodcarving, pottery, photos, decorative arts, hobby crafts, needle arts, quilts and quilted items, crochet ... if you make it, we want to sell it for you. There are some exceptions, however. We are not able to sell food items or canned goods. Space is limited; therefore, we will not be able to accept framed fine art or other items that are unusually large. Additionally, we will not knowingly accept items that are soiled, aged or made from kits. We reserve the right to reject items that may be objectionable or that are not of competition quality.

You will be assigned an exhibitor control number when you call to sign up for the program. **You must tag each of your items with your assigned control number, your own inventory control number, description and price** (example is shown at top of inventory list). These numbers must match your inventory list which will be turned in to the Store with your items. Please use the provided inventory form. You may request an inventory control sheet to be mailed, or print one online at www.georgianationalfair.com. You must use removable tags. Tags are removed at point of sale for inventory control. Tags must measure at least .75 inches by .75 inches and be easily read.

Our space is limited, but we will be selling for 11 days, so we will need a good number of items. Plan to bring up to 30 items; if we sell out and need more from you, we will call you to restock. There are no minimum limits. However, you should plan to consign enough inventory to cover the expense of including your items in the store. **Your items must be tagged and inventoried before you bring them.** Items not tagged and inventoried cannot be accepted. Please bring your items in a suitable storage container that can be stacked, which is labeled with your name and contact number. These containers will have to be stacked and stored for approximately a week before we have access to the Georgia Building to set up the store.

COMMISSION: The Fair will retain 20% of sales to cover costs of operating the Store. We ask that you volunteer your time as a worker in the store, if possible.

PAYMENT: Accounts will be settled after the Fair is over. Checks will be processed by Nov. 30, 2011.

TO SIGN UP: call, email or fax. We will give you a control number at that time. As soon as you have your inventory list complete, **send a copy to us** so that we will have an idea about what's coming in September.

The Store will be open during regular building hours during the Fair:

Weekdays noon-10 p.m., Weekends 10 am - 10 pm.
