

# HAND-PAINTED PORCELAIN

**Mail entry forms by September 15 for early registration.**

**1. All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the Georgia National Fair General Rules And Regulations.**

2. Open to Georgia residents that use the medium of paint on porcelain.

3. Artists may enter up to three works per category, except where stated otherwise.

4. No seminar pieces may be submitted.

5. All entries must be of porcelain. All others will be disqualified. Decal work will not be accepted.

6. Entries must be personal work of the exhibitor and must have FIRED SIGNATURE and DATE of completion. Please make certain that the frame does not conceal fired signature. Works must have been completed within the past three years.

7. Exhibitor's signature must be neatly concealed for judging. Tape will be removed after judging.

8. Judges may reclassify if an item is placed in the wrong category.

9. Each entry must be securely fastened together. Display stands will be furnished by the Georgia National Fair, except for pieces of unusual size.

**JUDGING CRITERIA FOR PAINTED PORCELAIN:****DESIGN COMPOSITION**

**AND EXECUTION: 80 pts.**  
Originality, Balance, Proportion, Harmony, etc. All the elements and principles working together.

**FIRING: 20 pts.**

Translucent in the colors, glossy and cleanness of the piece.

**USE OF DIFFERENT TECHNIQUES: (Bonus Points awarded at judges' discretion)** Rookwood, Enamel. Grounding, Acid Etching, Gold and other metals applications, Raised Paste, Pen work, Lusters, Modern combinations.

Award of Excellence Rosette and \$25 may be awarded in each Division
