1. **All exhibitors are required to read and abide by the Georgia National Fair General Rules And Regulations.** Hobby Show Department Rules also govern this competition.

2. Each entrant may enter up to three items per class and must be solely the work of the entrant.

3. There are three divisions in the competition: Open, Advanced and Master. A first time entrant can enter any Division. If you have obtained Master or Advanced level, you must enter all your items in that division.

## OPEN

The Open Division is for beginners and anyone who is new to leathercraft.

## ADVANCED

Exhibitors who have won five (5) first place awards in the Open Division must move to Advanced

## MASTER

Exhibitors who have won ten (10) first place awards in the Advanced Division must move to Master.

4. No kits are accepted in the Master Division.

5. Entries must show no sign of wear and tear.

6. The entrant's name on all pieces must be covered.

7. If the judge knows that an item does not meet the above criteria, it will not be judged.

8. Judges will be instructed not to place an award unless merited.

9. The decision of the judges will be final.

## PREMIUMS

10. All premium money will be paid from the judges' record sheets and not from ribbons that may be attached to exhibits. Premium checks will be mailed within six weeks after the Fair is over.

### Class

- 1 Art Objects
- 2 Cases: Books and book covers (*Book covers and notebooks must contain book or paper pad.*), *holsters and sheaths, carrying and sporting cases, purses.*
- 3 Household Items; (If a piece is made to hold something *specific - paper towels, etc., please include it so that the piece will be functionally complete.*
- 4 Large Complex Items; Furniture, Horse gear, saddles.
- 5 Pictures; *All pictures must be hand tooled, properly hung or displayed.*
- 6 Pocket Items; wallets, clutch purses, etc.
- 7 Wearing Apparel
- 8 Other Not Listed (canes, rifle slings and any other leather item for which there is no specific class)
