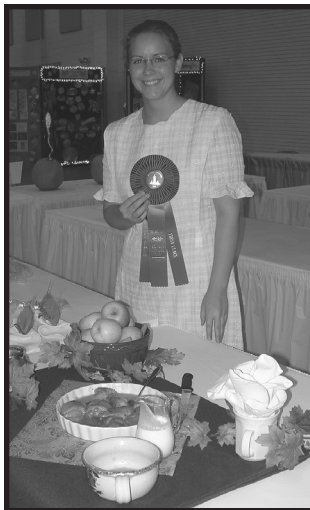
Mail your entry form by September 20 for early registration.
