

BUDDING ARTIST PROGRAM

FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12

Each year the Georgia National Fair receives many inquiries from parents of young children asking how their youngsters can participate in the competitions in the Georgia Living Home Arts and Fine Arts Program.

The Georgia National Fair Youth Art Exhibition uses guidelines established by Georgia art educators with regard to proper age limits for competition. They recommend that children below age 12 should not have their work juried. Our rules comply with their recommendations and we have adopted their philosophy to govern competitions throughout the Georgia Living Program. Exceptions to this rule apply only to "live" contests on site where parents are nearby to lend support, such as the Soap Carving Contest and the IronKids Awesome Sandwich Contest.

"Budding Artists" is an opportunity for children below age 12 to become exhibitors in the Georgia Living Home Arts and Fine Arts Programs. **Their work will not be judged.** *No prize money will be offered.* However, each exhibitor will receive a Georgia National Fair participation ribbon and their work will be displayed.

GENERAL RULES

1. Parents must read general rules at the beginning of this book which govern all competitions.
2. All exhibitors must register by completing and mailing an official entry form.
3. Budding Artists' exhibits will be accepted during general receiving, September 15-16, at the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building.

NO SUNDAY RECEIVING - NO SUNDAY RELEASE!

4. Work must have been completed by the Budding Artist within the past year.
5. Each Budding Artist may submit a maximum of two (2) items from the list below:
6. Drawings, paintings and photography must be mounted on fomecore or mount board. Do not attach wire or strings for hanging. Do not frame. Size limit for all two-dimensional entries is 16" x 24".
7. Three-dimensional pieces must not be fragile. All clay must be fired.

Class

- 1 Two-dimensional: Drawings, painting, photography
- 2 Three-dimensional: Constructions, objects of clay, ceramics, fiber
