RULES

All exhibitors are asked to read general rules at the beginning of this book and at the beginning of the Horticulture Department.

1. Show will be conducted according to ACS Rules and Regulations as revised 1994.
2. **Entries will be received 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Oct. 14; local entries must be completed by 10:30 a.m.** No limit on number of blooms of any variety.
3. No one bloom can win more than one award.
4. Any amateur grower may exhibit; exhibitor does not have to be a member of any camellia society or garden club.
5. Classification as to size will be in accordance with Camellia Nomenclature 2002; where a bloom is classified to include two sizes, the smaller size shall be accepted as the proper one for awards, except miniature to small, the small will apply.
6. Containers will be furnished. Blooms should have stems no longer than 2 inches and have one but not more than two leaves.
7. Blooms entered become the property of the Camellia Show Committee and will be destroyed after the show for disease prevention.
8. The Georgia National Fair and the show committee will provide as much protection as possible, but neither the Fair nor the show committee will assume responsibility for loss or damage to any exhibit or personal property.
