The Georgia Egg Commission and the Georgia National Fair invite you to help celebrate **Good Eggs from Georgia** with the **I Love Eggs "Dreamy Breakfast" Contest**. This contest is open to individuals or teams of two. **Contestants must be at least 16 years old by October 1, 2006. The 2005 first place winner is not eligible to compete in 2006.**

Each dish must contain at least two eggs as a main ingredient and serve a minimum of four people, and meet the theme "I Love Eggs Dreamy Breakfast Contest." The recipe should be prepared in advance, ready for judging and should be brought to the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building between 4:00 and 4:30 p.m. Contestants who wish to prepare their dish on site should arrive by 2:00 p.m. There will be a microwave oven; electric oven and surface unit available. Contestants are responsible for all other equipment and ingredients necessary to prepare their dish. Preparation and cooking time will be limited to one hour (3:00 - 4:00 p.m.).

Show your ingredients and/or dish to the personnel at **ANY GATE** to receive free entry into the Fair for one person or team of two. Bring your entry to the Miller-Murphy-Howard Building.

The recipe should be printed or typed on an 8 ½ x 11 inch sheet of paper and must be submitted with your entry at the contest. Your name, address, telephone number and the Division number for this contest must be printed on the back of the recipe. All recipes will become the property of the Georgia Egg Commission and the Georgia National Fair.

Contestants will be given a 15 inch x 32 inch space on an 8-foot table for their presentation.

Entries will be judged equally on presentation for the most creative "Dreamy" theme, originality, taste appeal and ease of preparation.
