- 1 Functional Buffet Table, Informal  
(components set up for service of food)

*Definition of Functional: Table exhibit planned and set for actual service of food; table could actually function as displayed. Include dishes, crystal or glassware, linens and floral design(s) with or without other components. Convenience and a sense of order must prevail.*

**Tables must be reserved by October 1. Tables must be completed Sunday evening October 8 between 7:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. and Monday morning, October 9 between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. and will remain in place until Tuesday, October 10, 7:00 p.m. when removal begins.** Participants will receive a Lot 2 parking pass which will permit parking and unloading very near set-up area.

This contest is open to individuals or teams of up to four people. Contestants must be 16 years old by October 1, 2006.

The theme for the tables is "Let's Celebrate Discovery." \*October 9th is Columbus Day. Let's celebrate the bravery and spirit of adventurers past and present who Put Their Dreams in Motion!

Tables are 8' long, 30-31" wide and 29 3/4-30" high (floor to top of table); topped and skirted with white plastic. **Overlay cloths must be provided by the exhibitor.**

The setting must be a functional buffet table, service for four or more. Please do not bring food or valuable small items; use of expensive flatware is discouraged.

Fresh, dried or silk plant material permitted; designer's choice. Uncut fruit and vegetables may be used.
