Bring finished product in at least a one quart size container. Show your ingredients and/or dish to the personnel at **ANY GATE** to receive free entry into the Fair for one person.

Your dish must be sweet potato based. The dish must be cooked before arrival. The recipe, printed or typed on an 8½ x 11 inch sheet of paper, must be submitted with the dish. Your name, address, telephone number and this Contest Division Number must be printed on the back of the recipe. All recipes will become the property of the Georgia National Fair.

The basic rules of food safety must be followed. See page 65. Please tape your name to all containers; they will be returned to you after judging is complete.

Contestants will not be allowed to “place” their entries, so please do not bring decorative items. Presentation is not a part of the judging score card.

Recipes will be judged on:

- Taste appeal40%
- Originality of recipe.....20%
- Appearance20%
- Ease of preparation10%
- Prominence of Georgia Sweet Potatoes
